

March in the Marietta 4th of July Parade

Every year, Scouts carry the large American Flag in the center of the Marietta City 4th of July Parade. This flag is huge, so we need every available scout, cub, scouter and parent to come help. It is a quick and easy way to support our city, nation, and Scouting!

Parade Details: The parade begins at 10:00am at Roswell Street Baptist Church and travels west on Roswell Street, north on East Park Square past Glover Park and the Square, down Cherokee Street and ends at North Marietta Parkway.

Meeting Information: We will meet at 9:30 in the West Parking Lot of Roswell Street Baptist Church, adjacent to Victory Dr. We will be assigned a meeting spot in the parking lot that morning, and a GroupMe message will be sent with more exact coordinates and a meeting spot # once that is known.

Parking Logistics: It is recommended that you find a place to park near Roswell Street Baptist Church. Buses will be running from the endpoint back to the beginning of the route. Alternately, you can park near the endpoint and walk up to the church, and then experience the route twice! There is not much parking at the church itself due to the parade formation, and streets will be closing as the parade start time approaches, so take this into consideration
