

March in the Marietta 4th of July Parade



Come and help us represent Scouting in the Metro Atlanta area as we celebrate the 250th anniversary of the signing of the U.S. Declaration of Independence. Every year, Scouts carry the large American Flag in the center of the Marietta City 4th of July Parade. This flag is huge, so we need every available scout, cub, scouter, and parent to come help. It is a quick and easy way to support our city, nation, and Scouting!

Meeting Information: We will meet at 9:00 AM in the West Parking Lot of Mission Church Roswell Street (formerly Roswell Street Baptist Church), adjacent to Victory Dr. We will be assigned a meeting spot in the parking lot that morning, and once I find out our exact location, I will update the website and calendar with that info.

Parking Logistics: It is recommended that you find a place to park near Mission Church. Buses will be running a shuttle from the end of the parade back to Mission Church. The end of the parade route will be very crowded, and non-parade vehicles are prohibited. There is no parking at Mission Church, and the streets will be closing (around 9:00 AM) as the parade start time approaches, so take this into consideration

Parade Details: The parade begins at 10:00am (rain or shine) at Mission Church and travels west on Roswell Street, north on East Park Square past Glover Park and the Square, down Cherokee Street and ends at North Marietta Parkway.

Some Details:

- Cub Scouts MUST have an adult in charge of them AND WITH them during the walk.
- Scouts must have an adult or a buddy.
- Watch the weather forecast for potential rain. Dress accordingly.
- BSA rules forbid us from carrying or displaying any political advertisements as part of the Scout group.
- Bring Water! Drink Water!
- The route is approx. 1.5 miles traveling along Roswell Rd past the Marietta National Cemetery. It takes a right onto East Park Street/Cherokee St in the square and ends at the corner of Cherokee and Kennesaw Ave.
- Let's have some fun representing the Foothill District, the Atlanta Area Council and Scouting America during our Nation's 250th Birthday Parade!
